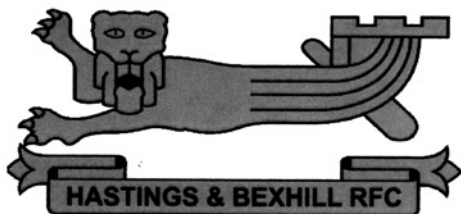

The presentation of the winners' trophies, runners-up medals and the Fair Play trophy will follow shortly after the completion of the finals.

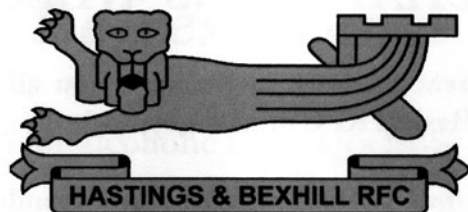
I would personally like to thank all the volunteers for their hard work and dedication that goes towards making our festival such a success.

Basic Code of Conduct for players/parents/carers

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgments.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.

Tournament Rules

This years festival is being run with pools for each age group.

Match Laws are those laid down by the RFU using the guide-lines within the Rugby Continuum.

Players must play within their age groups with the exception of the following:

The two player rule of dispensation.

In all games teams will be awarded points in the following way:

Win =3. Draw =2. Loss=1.

No extra time will be played in a game.

All trys must be recorded.

Should a pool be drawn on points:

Then the team with the most Trys scored, less Trys scored against them wins.

If still drawn then the toss of a coin will decide

The winning team from each pool will enter the final to decide the overall winner.

Any final ending in a draw will be decided by the toss of a coin.

A referee's decision is final during a game.

Please be at your designated playing area before the end of the game being played prior to your own. Pitch Marshals will be on hand to advise you through the day and to take scores to the control area.
